

## MILLS COUNTY'S MAJOR SPORTS STORIES OF 2022



### 1. Glenwood Cross Country

Glenwood's girls and boys cross country teams continued their dominance this season by sweeping the Hawkeye 10 Conference titles and both teams punching their tickets to the state meet for the second straight season. The boys had seven individual state qualifiers and went on to place sixth at state while the girls qualified three runners and placed eighth.



### 2. Glenwood Girls Basketball

The Glenwood girls won the Hawkeye 10 Conference and then defeated Winterset in a 76-43 blowout to punch its third straight trip to the Iowa State Girls Basketball Tournament. The Rams' run came to an end in the state semifinals in a 68-51 loss to Bishop Heelan.



### 3. Glenwood Wrestling

For the first time in over 15 years, the Glenwood wrestling team had two grapplers reach the finals at the Iowa State Wrestling Tournament. The Rams' 126-pound Matthew Beem and 195-pound C.J. Carter swept through their brackets to wrestle for state championships. Both Beem and Carter would go on to place second.



### Glenwood Football

The Glenwood football team overcame a plethora of injuries and one of the toughest schedules in all of Class 4A to reach the state playoffs and become just the third team in school history to win a postseason game. The Rams went on the road to defeat Spencer 38-26 in the playoffs. Their season would come to an end in a 58-22 loss to eventual state runner up Council Bluffs Lewis Central in the quarterfinals.

### 5.

#### Camden puts name in Rams' record

Glenwood's Madison Camden became the school's all-time leader in points and three-pointers last January. The current Peru State guard finished her Ram career with 1,473 points and 209 three-pointers.

#### Malcom Wins National Title

Glenwood graduate and 2016 state wrestling champion Matt Malcom won his second national title at the Division II National Wrestling Championships last March. The University of Nebraska-Kearney senior won the 157-pound title in 2019 and then followed it up with a 165-pound title this past season.

#### Williams Tops East Mills' All-Time Scoring Chart



With her 22 points in a 69-29 win over Bedford on Dec. 20, East Mills senior Emily Williams broke the school's scoring record of 992 career points held by Devin Laughlin. Williams currently sits at 1,009 career points.

### 8.

#### Trio of Rams headed to Division I

Glenwood's Logyn Eckheart, Jenna Hopp and Nora Dougherty signed letters-of-intent this fall to play Division I athletics next season. Eckheart signed with North Dakota for football, Hopp with South Dakota State for basketball and Dougherty for soccer at the University of Northern Colorado.

#### Glenwood Boys Soccer

The Glenwood boys soccer team's 2022 season came to an end a win short of the state tournament in a tough, rainy 2-0 loss to Council Bluffs Lewis Central in the Class 2A, Substate 8 championship last June. The Rams' ended the season with a record of 15-3, their best since the 2013-2014 season.

#### Christiansen Steps Down at Fremont-Mills

Jeremy Christiansen, the longtime football coach at Fremont-Mills stepped down from the position he had held for 18 years to accept the superintendent position at his alma mater, the Boyer Valley Community School District. From 2010 to his final season in 2021, Christiansen's team compiled a record of 109-20, reached the playoffs every season, the state semifinals five times and won the state championship in 2011.

including but not limited to any preference to bidders, the imposition of any type of labor force preference, or any other form of preferential treatment to bidders or laborers from that state or foreign country. The preference allowed shall be equal to the preference given or required by the state or foreign country in which the nonresident bidder is a resident. In the instance of a resident labor force preference, a nonresident bidder shall apply the same resident labor force preference to a public improvement in this state as would be required in the construction of a public improvement by the state or foreign country in which the nonresident bidder is a resident.

Each bidder shall accompany its bid with bid security as defined in Iowa Code Section 26.8, as security that the successful bidder will enter into a contract for the work bid upon and will furnish after the award of contract a corporate surety bond, in a form acceptable to the Jurisdiction, for the faithful performance of the contract, in an amount equal to 100% of the amount of the contract. **CITY OF GLENWOOD ORDINANCE NO. 925**

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES FOR THE CITY OF GLENWOOD, IOWA, BY AMENDING PROVISIONS CONCERNING ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLES AND SNOWMOBILES.

BE IT ENACTED by the City of Glenwood, Iowa:

SECTION AMENDED: Chapter 75, Section 05, Subsection 1, of the City Code of Ordinances is hereby amended to read in full as follows:

**75.05 OPERATION OF ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLES.** Any operator of an ATV shall be a minimum of eighteen

(18) years of age and shall possess a valid Iowa driver's license, except as otherwise provided by this chapter or the Iowa Code. All operators of ATV's shall comply with the following restrictions as to where ATVs may be operated within the City.

\* \* \*

1. RESTRICTED AREAS OF OPERATION.

A. Other restrictions shall include the following:

(1) Trails. An ATV shall not be operated on snowmobile trails except where designated.

(Code of Iowa, Sec. 321I.10[3])

(2) Railroad Right-of-Way. ATVs shall not be operated on a railroad right of way, unless being done so by a railroad employee for work purposes. ATVs may be driven directly across a railroad right-of-way only at an established crossing and notwithstanding any other provisions of law may, if necessary, use the improved portion of the established crossing after yielding to all oncoming traffic.

(Code of Iowa, Sec. 321I.14[h])

(3) Parks and Other City Land. ATVs shall not be operated in any park, playground or upon any other City-owned property without the express

permission of the City.

(4) Sidewalk or Parking. ATVs shall not be operated upon the public sidewalk or that portion of the street located between the curb line and the sidewalk or property line commonly referred to as the "parking".

(5) An ATV shall not be parked upon any City sidewalk.

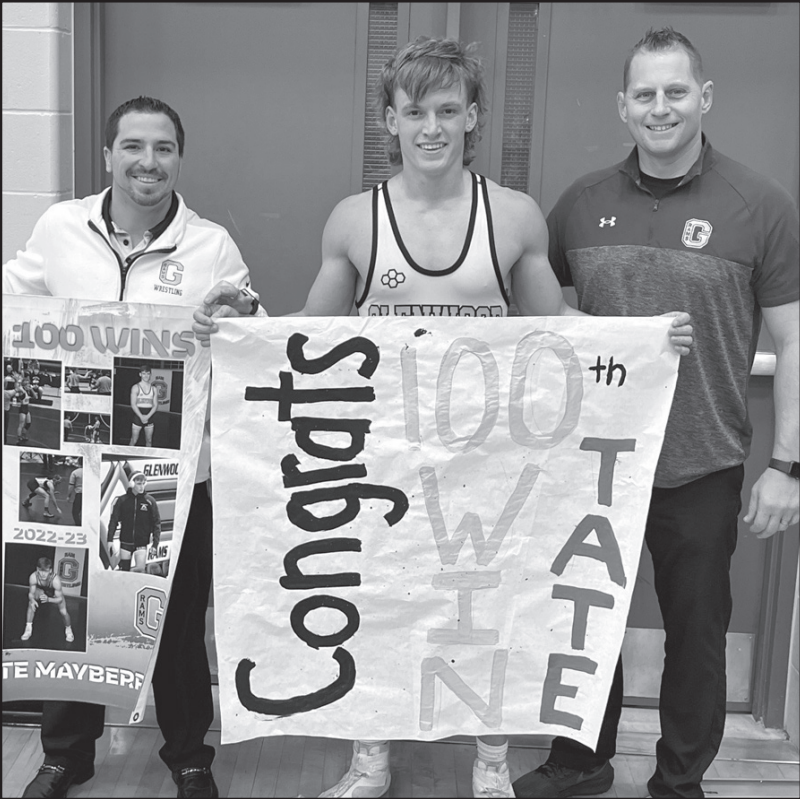
